Seminar overview:

Day one: 19 September

On the first day, attendees will be introduced to and develop skills and competencies in the use of forum theatre, through practical based teaching on setting up a forum play, warm-up and value exercises and guidance on being a facilitator.

Day two: 31 October

This follow up day will offer attendees instruction in the use of digital media with forum theatre and explore its applications with young people. Additionally, the programme will give a focus and foundation to the philosophy of using Forum Theatre and digital media and any ethical considerations that may arise.

The UK seminars will be facilitated by Risto Ruottunen, a Finnish drama teacher with experience in forum theatre, and Niels Ole Ankerstjerne from VIFIN, Denmark, an expert on the incorporation of digital media in teaching and learning.
