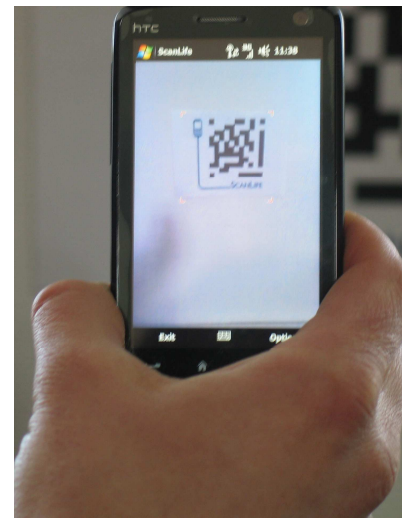
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Youths learning with IT Trends

Proposal

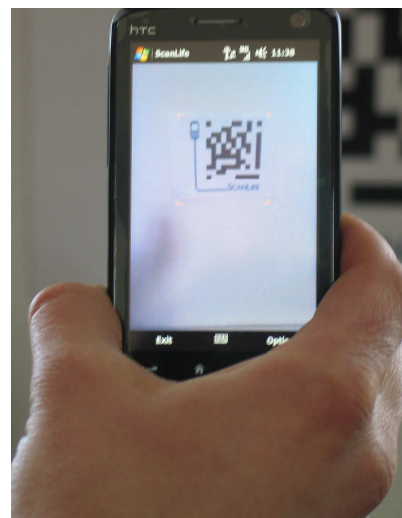
Starting with reflections on cognition ...

- Prior knowledge => **pre-activities (1)**
- Attention => **main activities (2)**
- Use => **post activities (3)**

3 activities together with a **social** and **meaningful** perspective on learning
